

Fuyu (Jiro) Persimmon

Diospyros kaki

The number one fresh eating persimmon sold in America.

Large, round, flattened. Reddish-orange skin. Good eating. Non-astringent.

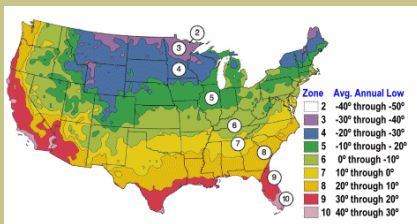
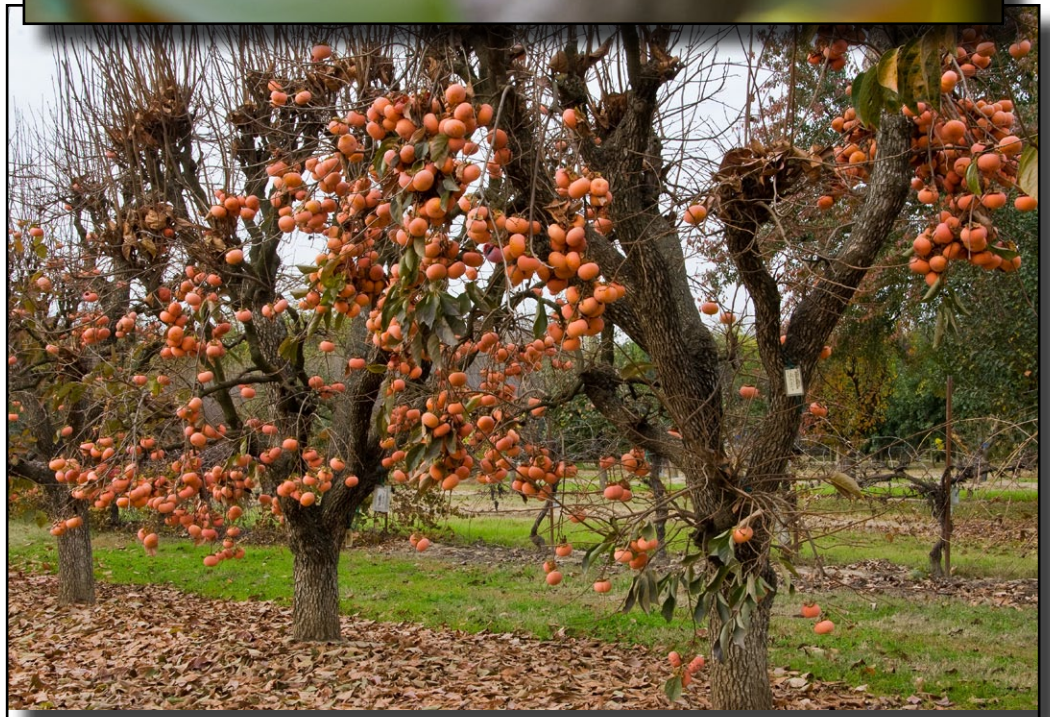
Bears at a young age and is a heavy producer. Does not have male flowers so it will not have seeds unless planted with other varieties.

Ripens in November

Mature height is 20-30 feet with a spread of 10-15 feet.

Requires less than 200 hours chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.



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
