

Moorpark Apricot

Prunus armeniaca sp.

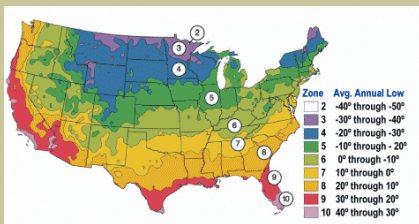
Large in size. Brownish-red skin. Firm, highly colored flesh; rich luscious flavor. Favorite for fresh eating, preserves and pies.

Requires 600-700 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: Late June to Early July.

Mature height is 20 feet with a spread of 20-25 feet.

Cold Hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.



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
