

Champagne Peach

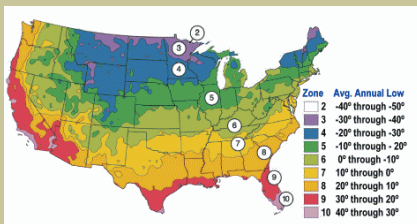
Prunus persica sp.

Very large. Round fruit with a light reddish blush and light pubescence. Clear white flesh with attractive red at pit. Smooth, melting texture; fine sweet flavor, well balanced. Flavor quality is excellent when picked firm ripe and held at room temperature 3 to 4 days. Very productive tree.

Requires 650 hours of chilling below 45°F.

Ripens in mid-August.

Cold hardy to
U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
